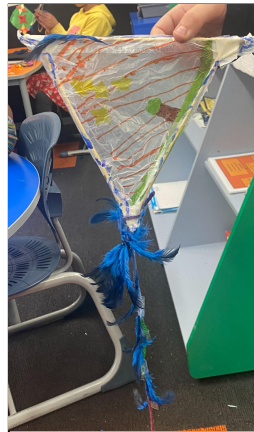




**Matariki**
