To help us be best prepared on Monday morning could you please send your child to school with:

- A clean face (no food, no sleep, clean nose)
- Clean, detangled hair please treat for nits during the weekend if needed
- A named hairbrush or comb (only if you'd prefer your child to use their own)
- A named, black mascara (if you'd prefer your child to use their own)

And if possible:

- Autumn group Hair DOWN
- Winter group Hair in a low ponytail, boys hair off face.
- Spring group Hair either in one or two, high ponytails or high buns child's choice. Keep headdress in mind.
- Summer- Girls hair in high ponytail, boys hair brushed and styled.

Other reminders:

- Children need an energy filled lunch and big drink of water, a jacket and footwear to wear to the performance venue.
- There is no audience. We will let you know when the video of our performance is released online.
- We will return late to school after our performance. We will be in Room 26 once we return. All children must return to the classroom to change out of their costume which must not be worn home. Boys and girls will be changing in separate rooms.
