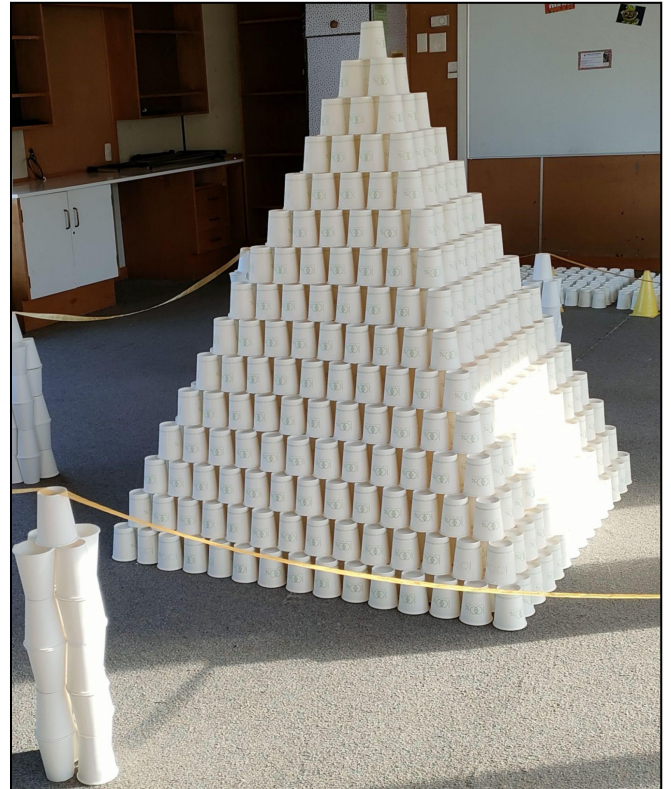
#### Mobile Dental Van

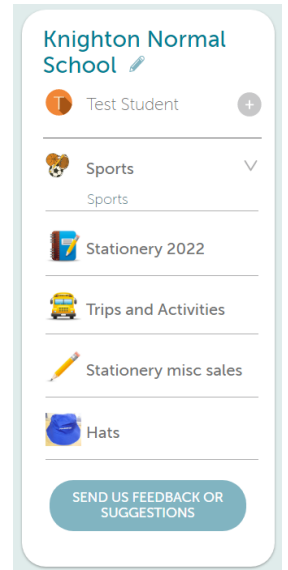
We are excited to remind you about our Kindo online shop! You can pay for activities, trips, stationery and also register and provide permission for sports –all online and at a time that suits you.
