Dear Parents/Caregivers of Room 11,

Welcome back to another school year! I hope you all enjoyed a nice relaxing break with your children. My name is Grant Miller and I have been lucky enough to meet quite a few of you already. I am very excited about working with the students in Room 11 this year and I'm sure we will enjoy a wonderful year of learning together.

I have been teaching for 14 years, most of which has been at the Year 3 and 4 levels. This will be my ninth year at Knighton Normal School. I enjoy sport, the outdoors and love animals. Stationery

Using a Kindo account is the most efficient way to pay - and you don't need to send any paper forms back to school, so nothing gets lost in school bags. Alternatively you can use one of the options suggested on the stationery notice.

Swimming and Library

The swimming days for Room 11 are Tuesday 12:15-12:35, and Thursday 11:55 -12:15. Please help your child to remember their togs and towel in a named plastic bag or swimming bag on each of these days. Library day is Wednesday, please ensure your child brings their book on this day. Library visits will start in Week 3. (15th February)

Homework

I will encourage reading every night and children will have spelling words they will be learning. Other forms of homework based on our topic learning may be sent home at times.

Hats

School hats must be worn in Terms 1 and 4. If your child needs a new hat, one can be purchased from the school office for \$10. If your child does not have a school hat, they will only be able to play in the shade at break times.

Medical Needs

Should your child need any medication during the school day, please visit our Office where you will be asked to fill in a permission form and the medicine will be kept safely and administered when needed.

Tissues

To help maintain a healthy classroom we use tissues for runny noses and sneezes. If at any time during the year you can help us out by donating a box of tissues to our class we would be most grateful.
