This year there are four competition categories (see the next page for more information about each category)

- To demonstrate the Knighton Core Values at all times, to try their best and be proud representing Knighton in this event
- To demonstrate that they can be a team member
- To return the permission slip which is signed by an adult by Friday 1 November

As this event occurs on a Saturday, parents/caregivers are responsible for bringing their child to and from and also supervising their children during the event

2. Speech Category: 3 mins max

Question: "How does my Genealogy / Whakapapa / Gafa, strengthen who I am today"

3. Shoe Design Category

Shoe Design Template was emailed to participating schools on Monday 21st October 2024 for students to decorate/colour in how they like and hand it in on Competition Day for Judging.

Designs on shoes are to reflect 'Genealogy / Whakapapa/ Gafa'

4. Singing Competition Category

SOLO SINGER - (Schools can enter 1 and/or 2 students per school) to represent in this category. Max time to sing 3-mins.

Song choice is up to the student and their school/family.

Instrumental backing must be provided by Student/School & family, if played Live - student/School & family must provide their own instrument and lead to plug in. One other person can be on stage with Solo singer (guitarist, pianist, etc, NOT BACK UP VOCALIST)

A Backing Vocalist will only be accepted via instrumental backing track (should you choose to provide a backing track).
